The Bishop's January prayer: As we begin a new year, may the opportunities for the grace to clearly recognize the dignity of life, education and ecumenism allow u to better support our brothers and sisters who need the warmth of Christ's love and our compassion during this winter season.

Saint John, Apostle and Evangelist. Saint John was one Jesus' twelve apostles, having been one of the first called by Jesus at the beginning of his ministry. John is also considered to be the "Beloved Disciple," one of Jesus' closest companions. After Jesus ascended into heaven, John played a leading role in the first Christian community in Jerusalem and is designated in the Acts of the Apostles as a close co-worker with Saint Peter in his own evangelization efforts. John is also the author of the Gospel of John and four other books in the New Testament, three Epistles and the Book of Revelation.
